

Interim Erosion Control Plan

Interim Erosion Control Plans (Plans) shall be submitted to and approved by the City's Department of Development Services:

- prior to the start of construction and monthly during the period of May 1 to October 1,
- every 2 weeks during the period of October 1 to May 1 if the site is active and subject to erosion, or
- monthly maintenance reports shall be submitted if the site has been stabilized for the winter

Plans shall be prepared and monitored by a registered civil engineer experienced in erosion control, a certified professional soil erosion and sediment control specialist, or a soil scientist.

The interim plan shall use Best Management Practices (BMP).

Calculations for tributary areas:

- 5 acres and larger shall be based on a storm frequency of 10-year, 24-hour duration using the City BMP for "temporary sediment basins."
- Less than 5 acres shall be based on a storm frequency of 10-year, 6-hour duration using the City BMP for "temporary excavated impoundment."

The Interim Plan shall include methods to minimize turbidity selected from the City of Redding *Construction Standards* or Erosion Control Manual to the maximum extent practicable.
