

NOTICE INVITING BIDS
MARY STREET LIFT STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT
(Job No. 2271)
BID SCHEDULE NO. 4155

In accordance with the Municipal Code of the City of Redding, sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk, 777 Cypress Avenue, Redding, CA 96001, until 3 p.m., Thursday, March 4, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the performing of the work as follows:

The project consists of constructing a new lift station capable of pumping up to 4,100 gallons per minute (GPM) as well as demolition of the existing lift station once the new facility is operational. The project includes site preparation and excavation, cast-in-place and precast concrete, miscellaneous metals, concrete roof tiles, concrete coatings and painting, installation of dry-pit submersible pumps and sewage grinder, instrumentation and controls, miscellaneous piping and valve installation, and all other work as shown on the plans and described in these specifications.

The Engineer's Estimate is \$2,040,000.

The Contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time bid is opened.

A prebid conference is scheduled between staff and interested bidders at the Mary Street Lift Station, on Thursday February 18, 2010, at 9 a.m., at which time the project will be reviewed. All interested bidders are encouraged to attend.

Each bid shall be made in accordance with the specifications and proposal requirements thereof and no bid will be received unless it is made on a proposal form furnished by the City Engineer. Each bid must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check, or original bidder's bond made payable to the City of Redding for an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid as a guarantee that the contractor will execute the contract in conformance with his proposal and the specifications. Such guarantee shall be forfeited should the bidder to whom the contract is awarded fail to enter into the contract.

The City of Redding hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for this project is 15.47 percent.

This is a Federally assisted project. The general prevailing rate of per diem wages, holidays, and overtime work for each craft, classification, or type of workmen needed to execute the contract are established by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon and are located in the specifications and can be found at <http://www.gpo.gov/davisbacon/>. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) requirements apply to this project. In addition, the general prevailing rate of per diem wages, holidays, and overtime work for each craft, classification, or type of workmen needed to execute the contract are established by the State of California, Department of Industrial Relations, and are on file in the office of the City Clerk, City of Redding. If there is a difference between the minimum wage rate determined by the Secretary of Labor and the prevailing wage determined by the State of California for similar classifications of labor, the higher wage rate shall prevail. Contractors shall not pay wages less often than once per week.

Funding for this project has been provided in full or in part through an agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board. The contents of this document do not necessarily reflect the views and policies of the State Water Resources Control Board, nor does mention of trade names or commercial products constitute endorsement or recommendation for use.

No bid will be accepted from a contractor who is not licensed in accordance with the provisions of California Business and Professions Code Sections 7,000 et seq. and regulations adopted by the Contractors' State Licensing Board, as amended. The envelope enclosing the proposal shall have stated thereon, "Mary Street Lift Station Replacement Project, (Bid Schedule No. 4155)."
