

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested individuals can obtain an application from the City of Redding Housing Division. Once eligibility is determined, an inspector from this division will examine the property and discuss the feasibility of the project with the applicant. When a reasonable bid is secured and approved by the City of Redding, an agreement is signed and work may begin. The Housing Division staff will disburse funds, upon the completion of contracted work.
